## Off Campus Housing

From the Walker Avenue circle, take **HEAT 73** to apartment communities on Walker Avenue, Chapman Street, and Spring Garden Street. Ride free with a UNCG ID. [www.rideheat.com](http://www.rideheat.com)

## Downtown

From the Walker Avenue circle, take **HEAT 72** to the Depot downtown. Walk to restaurants, catch a Greensboro Grasshoppers baseball game, or board a connecting bus to travel around town. HEAT 72 also serves A&T University and Bennett College. Ride free with a UNCG ID. [www.rideheat.com](http://www.rideheat.com)

## Friendly Center

From the Walker Avenue circle, take **HEAT 71** west to Friendly Center for dining, movies, and shopping. HEAT 71 also serves Guilford College. Ride free with a UNCG ID. [www.rideheat.com](http://www.rideheat.com)

## Late Night and Weekends

From the Walker Avenue circle, take **HEAT 70/71** east to downtown or west to Guilford College with service until 3am Thursday through Saturday. Ride free with a UNCG ID. [www.rideheat.com](http://www.rideheat.com)

## Wendover Avenue Walmart

From the GTA bus stop at Spring Garden & Aycock, take **GTA 1** to the Wendover Avenue stop 4A near Bridford Parkway. Return to campus on GTA 1 and get off the bus at Spring Garden & Mayflower. Ride free with a UNCG ID. [www.ridegta.com](http://www.ridegta.com)

## Greensboro Coliseum Complex and Four Seasons Town Centre

From the GTA bus stop at Tate & Lee, take **GTA 2** to Florida & Coliseum (coliseum) or Four Seasons Town Centre (mall). Return to campus on GTA 2 and get off the bus at Spring Garden & Tate. Ride free with a UNCG ID. [www.ridegta.com](http://www.ridegta.com)

## The Beach

From the Walker Avenue circle, take **HEAT 72** to the Depot downtown, then board a **Greyhound** bus to Myrtle Beach, SC for around \$35 round trip. [www.greyhound.com](http://www.greyhound.com)

## The Mountains

From the Walker Avenue circle, take **HEAT 72** to the Depot downtown, then board the **PART Route 7 Mountaineer Express** to Boone. \$15 round trip for students; \$20 non-students. [www.partnc.org](http://www.partnc.org)



## The Zoo

From the Walker Avenue circle, take the **PART Route 10 Randolph County Express**. \$2 round trip for students; \$4 for non-students. [www.partnc.org](http://www.partnc.org)

## New York to New Orleans

From the Walker Avenue circle, take **HEAT 72** to the Depot downtown, then board **Amtrak**. Riders may connect to Atlanta and New Orleans in Charlotte. One-way fares as low as \$11 to Raleigh; \$15 to Charlotte; \$70 to Washington, DC; \$94 to New York. [www.bytrain.org](http://www.bytrain.org)

## And Beyond via Piedmont Triad International Airport (PTI)

From the Walker Avenue circle, take HEAT 72 to the Depot downtown, transfer to a PART bus going to the PART hub, then ride a complimentary PART shuttle to the Piedmont Triad International Airport. Shuttles operate Monday-Friday, 6:30am- 6:30pm. To request a pick up, call (336) 883-7278 (PART). *For shuttle service directly from UNCG to the airport, call Central Piedmont Transportation (877) 796-5466. # TRAVEL TIPS

✓ **Know where you are going and where to catch the bus throughout your adventure.** The UNCG transit hub is located behind the library tower near the Walker Avenue circle. Spartan Chariot, HEAT and PART buses stop at the Walker Avenue transit hub. Additional HEAT and GTA bus stops are located nearby:

✓ **Know when you need to get there and plan your time carefully.** Arrive early to the bus stop and allow extra time for connections, transfers, and walking.

✓ **Have your UNCG ID, fare card, and/or money ready when you board the bus.**

✓ **Ask if you need help.** Don't be shy or nervous about asking questions. Other riders, the bus drivers, and the UNCG Parking Operations & Campus Access Management staff are great resources for information.

Use your UNCG ID to ride green Greensboro Transit Authority (GTA) and orange/red Higher Education Area Transit (HEAT) buses free of charge. Without a valid ID, one-way fare is \$1.30. Routes are ideal for traveling between local college and university campuses, getting downtown, to Friendly Center, or to Four Seasons Town Center for dining, movies, shopping, and more. 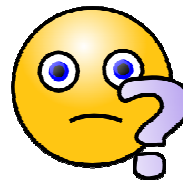


The Piedmont Authority for Regional Transportation (PART) offers a variety of commuter services including an emergency

ride home program, vanpools, direct bus routes from Davidson and Randolph counties to UNCG, plus routes to the Piedmont Triad International Airport, the NC Zoo in Asheboro, west to Boone, and east to Chapel Hill. 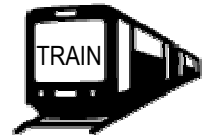
